NEW RIVER JET BOATS

Hawks Nest State Park

The jet boat is a custom designed craft which can haul up to 16 guests. It is propelled by a 502 Chevy engine and a direct drive Hamilton jet pump, which when on plane will cruise at about 30 mph.

You will ride the tram to the bottom of the mountain then check-in for the Jet Boats.

Jetboat Trip Itinerary

- 1.) Arrive at Hawks Nest State Park - Come as you are. "Miss M. Rocks" is covered and trips run rain or shine.
- 2.) Purchase your tram ticket at the tram office - You may purchase your Jet Boat Ticket from the MOF Shop at Glade Springs. Please be on the tram 15 minutes before your jetboat trip time.
- 3.) Take the tram ride down into the Gorge check in, and go to the dock. The boat must depart on time. Please don't be late.
- 4.) Climb on board "Miss M. Rocks". Your captain will take you upstream on the World's second oldest river, to the New River Gorge Bridge, towering 876 feet above you. The ride is 6 miles long and takes approximately 25 to 30 min

Pace of Play – Play Ready Golf!

Our pace of play policy is 4 hours and 15 minutes for 18 holes. If you notice your group falling behind the group ahead of you, it is important that you pick up your pace. Player Assistants will help you pick up the pace. If your group has fallen behind more than one hole, the Player Assistant or a member of the Golf Professional Staff may ask you to pick up your golf balls and move to a suitable location to improve the pace of play for the entire course.

Other Info

Check in for the Cobb and Stonehaven courses are located at the Clubhouse directly across from the Inn. Players should arrive at least 20-30 minutes prior to their tee time. Two-somes will be paired up with other golfers.

Location/Directions

Check in for the Cobb and Stonehaven is at the golf shop located in the Clubhouse – Across from the Inn.

Check in for Woodhaven is at the Woodhaven Clubhouse. Woodhaven Golf Course is located approximately 4 miles from the Inn. Directions are: Club Circle (past playground) to Greenbrier (go right). Take a left on Old Farm Rd. Turn right on Riverglade Rd. Follow the winding road to stop sign. Take a left. Approximately 1.5 miles on your left is the Woodhaven Clubhouse.

Leisure Center Activities

Bowling

We have a wonderful 10 lane bowling center which features laser bowling on weekends or at special request. The hours of operation for the bowling center change seasonally. The cost to bowl is just \$6.00 per person per game or we also have a special of \$15.00 per person for 2 hours of unlimited bowling. Both prices include your shoe rental. There is no age restriction for bowling, however shirt and shoes are required to be in the bowling center. Bowling is on a first come first serve bases. You can reserve lanes in advance if you have a party of 10 or more, however there is a 24 hour cancelation notice required. Private parties are available through our catering department. The bowling center features a large screen television, snacks, beer, and sodas.

Arcade

Test you skills in our arcade from driving games, shooting games, and even some old school games out of the 80's. The arcade also features a pool table, foosball table, and table tennis. Most games require .50 to play. Shirt and shoes are required in the arcade area.

Basketball

Our indoor basketball court provides fun for all ages so there is no rough play or profanity tolerated. The court can be reserved privately for a fee of \$50.00 per hour. Shirt and shoes are required and shoes need to have non marking soles.

Cinema

In our cinema we play family oriented movies daily at 1:00, 4:00, and 7:00 P.M. There is no charge to watch one of our features. Please check with the leisure center to assure there is not a private function in our cinema before making your plans to see a movie. Shirt and shoes are required in the cinema. All movies are rated PG13 or lower.

Indoor Pool

We have a beautiful 75,000 gallon indoor pool with a beach entry and 3 lap lanes. There is no lifeguard on duty and you must be at 18 years old or with a legal guardian to be in the pool area. No T-shirts or cut off shorts are allowed. You must have a bathing suit. The pool is only 5 feet at its deepest so there is no diving allowed. In our pool area there is also a large 1,800 gallon hot tub. Don't worry about bringing a towel we have them here for you. Our locker rooms also provide a swim suit dryer so you do not have to take a wet suit back with you.

Toddlers Play Area

Welcome to Pooh's Wonderland. There is a beautiful mural of all the Whinny the Pooh characters painted down the entire wall. There are two televisions which are kept on the Nicalodian or Cartoon Network channels. There is a ball pit, many toys, and soft blocks to occupy your child's imaginative mind. The toddlers play area is reserved for children 5 and under.

Fitness Center

We have a state of the art fitness center with Nautilus equipment, free weights, treadmills, bikes, and elliptical machines. Workout towels are provided for you at the leisure center desk as you come in. There is one large screen television and 8 small televisions provided in front of our tread mills and elliptical machines. Personal training is available with advance notice for a fee. To use the fitness center you must be 16 years of age. Shirt and closed toe shoes are required.
